

DIGITAL TIPTax card

- When you receive earned income (e.g. wage or taxable benefits), you must pay
 taxes on it. Tax is withheld from your salary according to your tax rate. The tax
 rate is determined by the amount of earned income you receive during the year
- Employer checks your tax rate from your tax card. Every year you will receive a new tax card for wage by mail and on MyVero. Tax rate on this tax card is calculated based on your income during the previous year. Check with your employer if you have to provide them with your tax card or if they get the information directly from the Tax Administration.
- On the tax card you will see your tax rate and income ceiling, which means how much income you can receive during the year. Make sure you're not exceeding the income ceiling by checking your payroll or incomes register information regularly.
- If your income change, your tax rate can be too high or low. It is possible to make changes to your tax card and get a revised tax card. You can change your tax card in MyVero. You will need an estimate of your income for the remainder of the year. You can get a revised tax card as many times as you need during the year.
- If you receive trade income instead of wage, you
 will need a specific kind of tax card. You can also
 get a specific tax card for benefits because wage
 and benefits are taxed differently.
